

Three Directors Earn National Certifications

Three members of the JPEC board of directors recently earned educational credentials from the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA).

Lori Thompson, the director for District 4, earned the Credentialed Cooperative Director (CCD) certificate.

The CCD criteria require that electric cooperative directors participate in and earn a passing grade in five core courses:

- Directors' Duties and Liabilities
- Board Roles and Relationships
- Understanding the Electric Business
- Strategic Planning
- Financial Decision Making

Thompson works as the director of clerical services for the McCracken County Emergency Management Complex and resides in Graves County.

Erick Harris, the director for District 6, and Jack Marshall, the director for

District 8, each earned a Board Leadership Certificate (BLC) from NRECA.

Directors earn the BLC certificate by participating in 10 advanced courses focusing on four major policy areas:

- Governance
- Energy, Power Supply, and Technology
- Members, Communications, and Grassroots
- Finance

Directors may not earn the BLC certificate until they have earned the CCD certificate.

Harris works at Arkema Inc. in Calvert City as a process control supervisor and resides in McCracken County.

Marshall worked in construction, owned rental property, raised cattle and owned a grocery in Marshall County prior to his retirement. He resides in McCracken County.

JPEC Promotes Breast Cancer Awareness and Raises Funds



- Never overload an outlet with too many lights.

- If you choose to have a live tree, keep it watered to minimize the risk of fire.
