Greg Grissom named new President & CEO

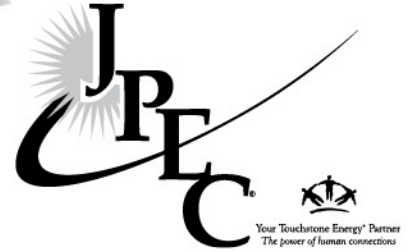

Michele Teitloff.

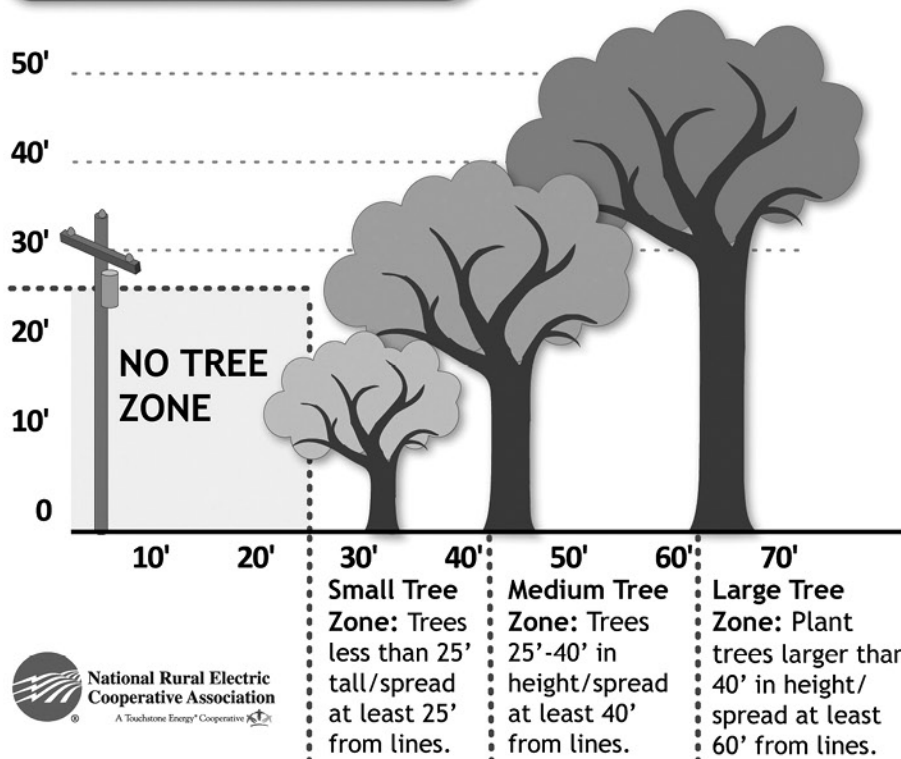
Joshua Barnes (District 4) Electrician, graduate of Mayfield Creek Christian Academy, married to Darla Barnes.
