2026 JPEC \$1,000 Scholarship Application

Jackson Purchase Energy Cooperative's college scholarship program is one aspect of JPEC's continuing effort to further the education of the region's students.

The scholarships awarded may be used at any accredited university or community college and for any course of study in the curriculum.

To qualify:

- You must be enrolled currently as a senior at a local high school or home school and plan to enroll in a full-time course of study (12 hours per semester) at an accredited university or community college no later than the fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- Your primary residence must be served by JPEC.
- You must have a GPA of at least 2.5 and an ACT score of 18 or higher.
- You must *not* be the child or grandchild of a JPEC employee, director, or attorney.
- If selected, you must record and submit an acceptance video by May 1, 2026.

The application must be received no later than Friday, February 20, 2026:

- A completed, typed application.
- A letter of recommendation.
- A brief typed narrative stating your reason for applying for the scholarship. The narrative should include any special needs, financial or otherwise and your plans for the future.
- An official <u>signed</u> school transcript of courses and grades to date.
