Attention, high school juniors! Are you a leader in your school, community or church?

JPEC is looking for leaders like you to serve as delegates to represent your school in the 2026 Youth Tour. Representatives will travel to Frankfort, Kentucky as part of Kentucky's Rural Electric Cooperative Youth Tour program. *The dates of the trip are March 18 and 19 and will include an overnight stay.* Students will participate in the Old State Capitol Tour, visit the Ky History Museum, and much more.

Up to four students are then chosen from the Frankfort, KY Youth Tour to represent JPEC in an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, DC June 15 – June 20.

To qualify:

- You must be between the ages of 16 and 18 currently and enrolled as a junior at a local high school or home school.
- Your primary residence must be served by Jackson Purchase Energy Cooperative.
- You must *not* be the child or grandchild of a JPEC employee, director, or attorney.

Submit a completed application, short essay, letter of recommendation, and current transcript with courses and grades to Jackson Purchase Energy Cooperative no later than Friday, January 30, 2026.
